

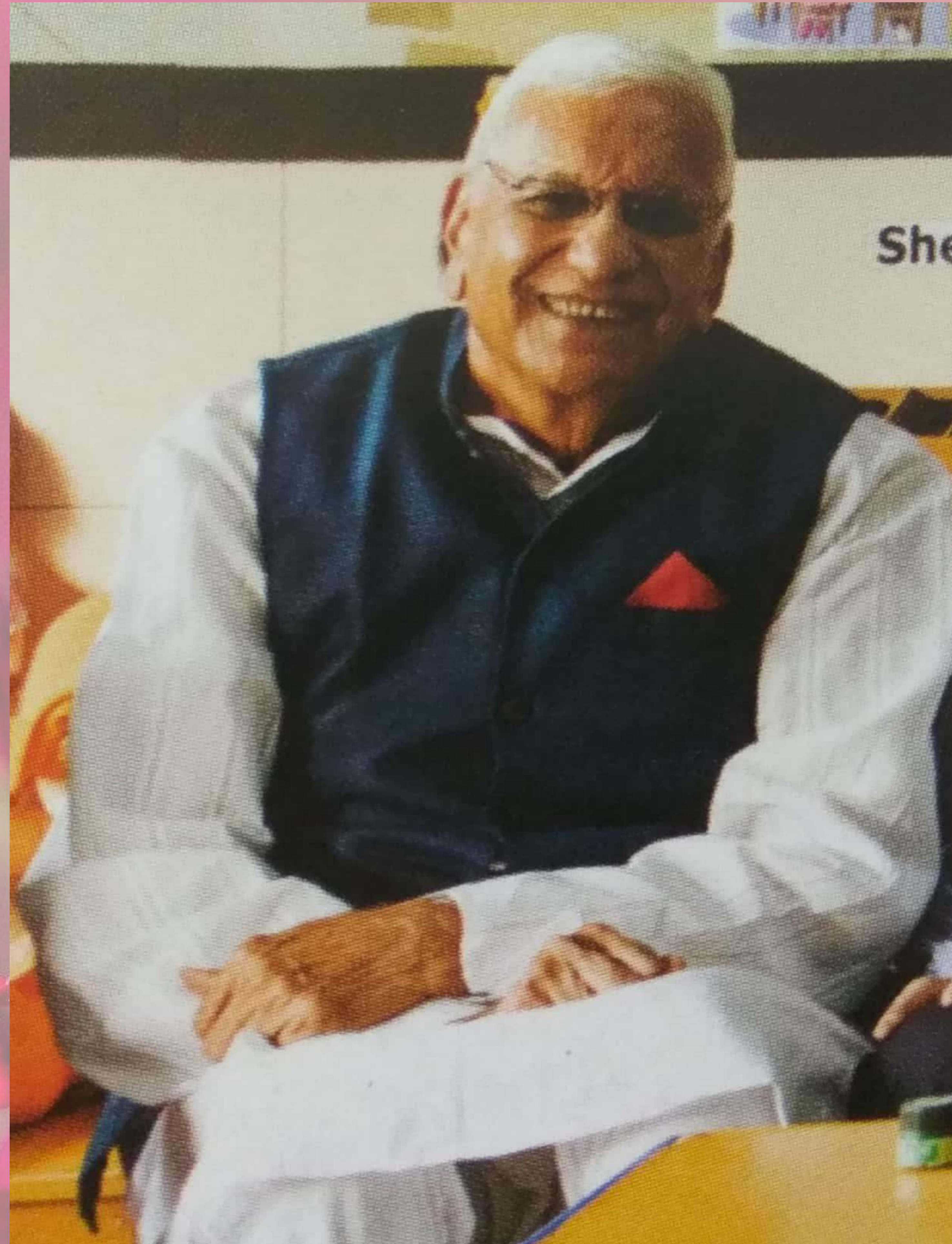
Chief Workshop Manager, CRWS

securing 93.6%




Poonam Sahu topped



In the same event, Mrs. Shamim Akhtar was felicitated by ‘रचनात्मक प्रतिभा शिक्षक सम्मान 2018’.



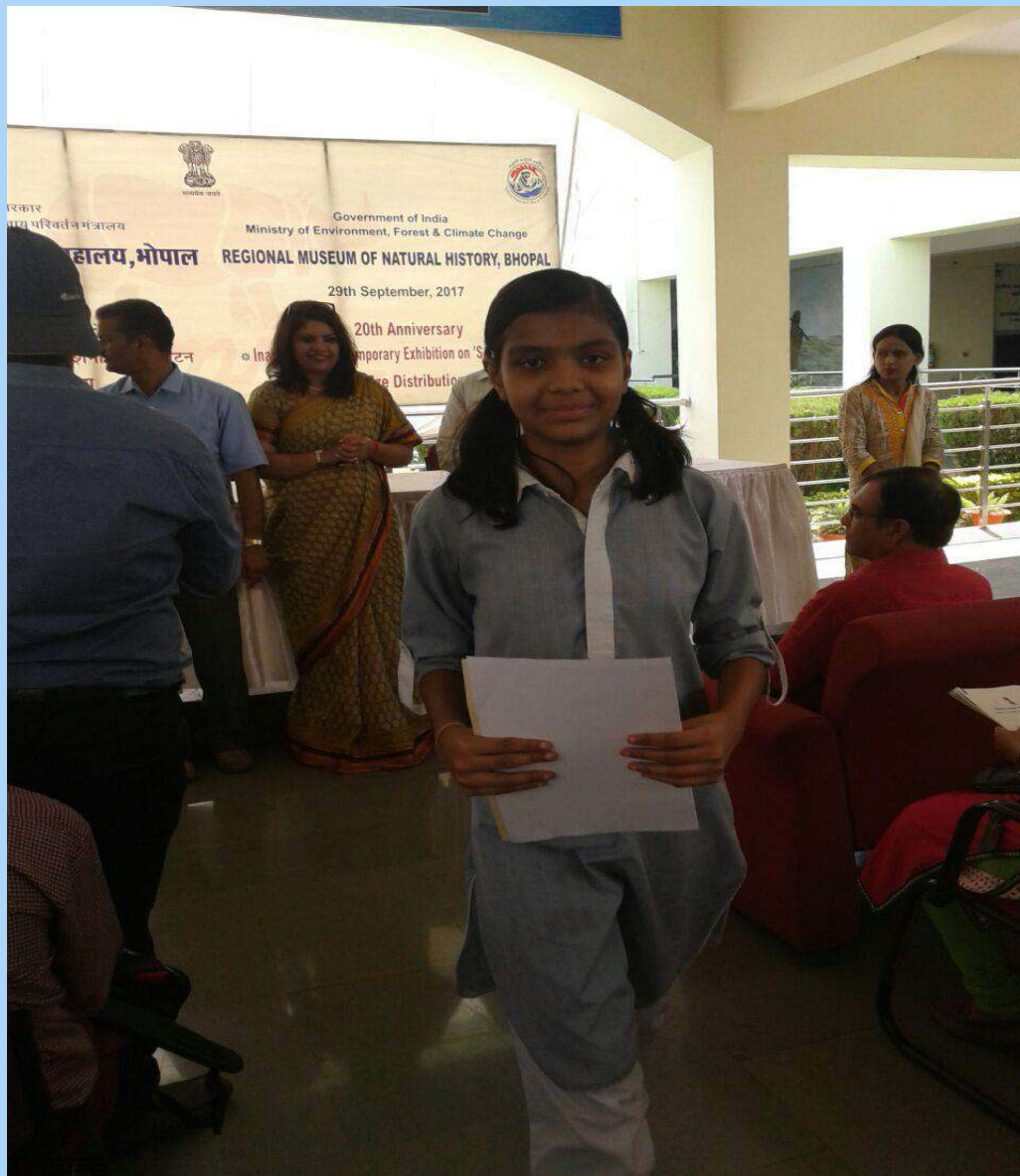
