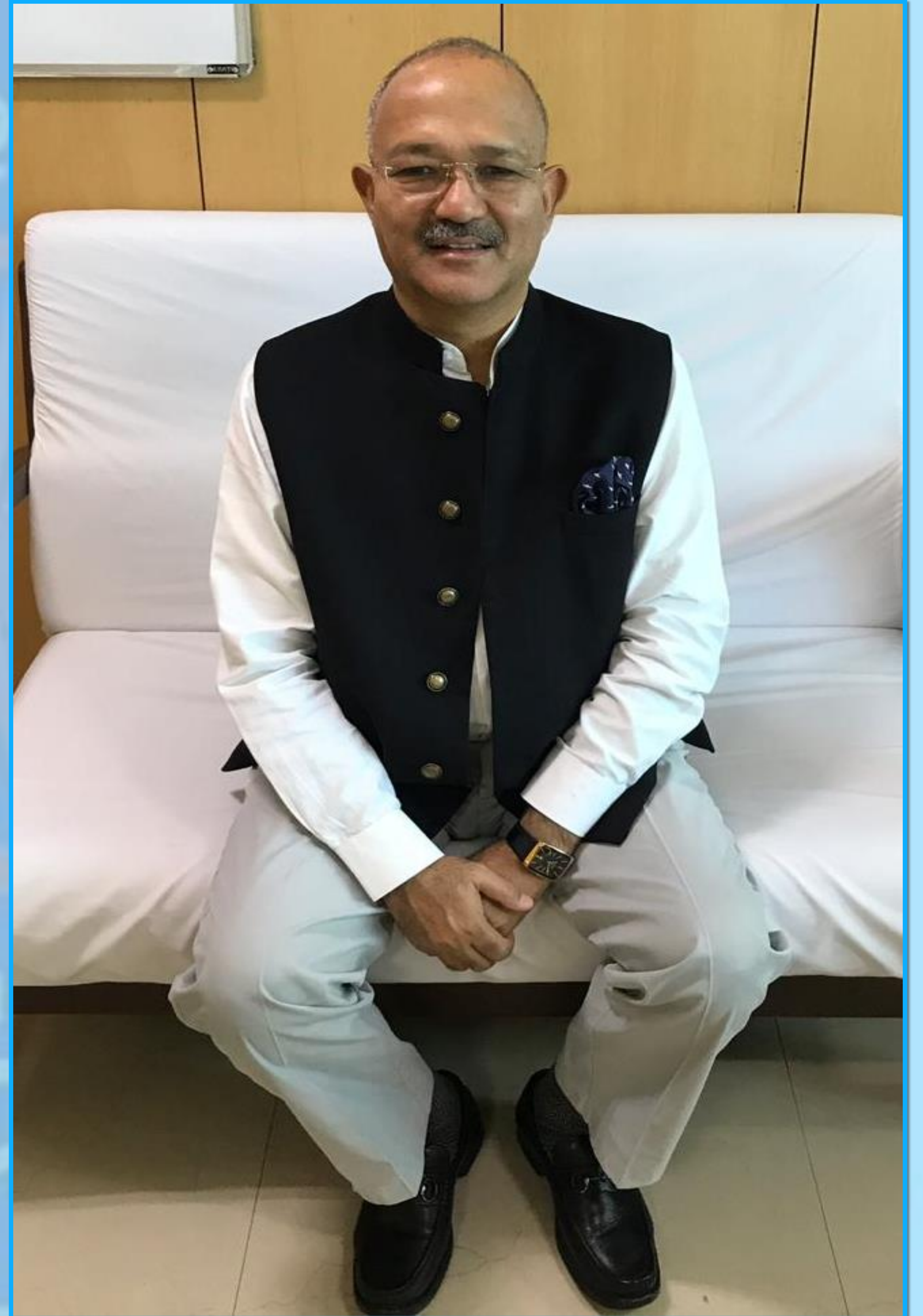


I extend a hearty and a warm welcome to all present here, on the momentous occasion of our 26th Annual Day and Prize Distribution Ceremony.

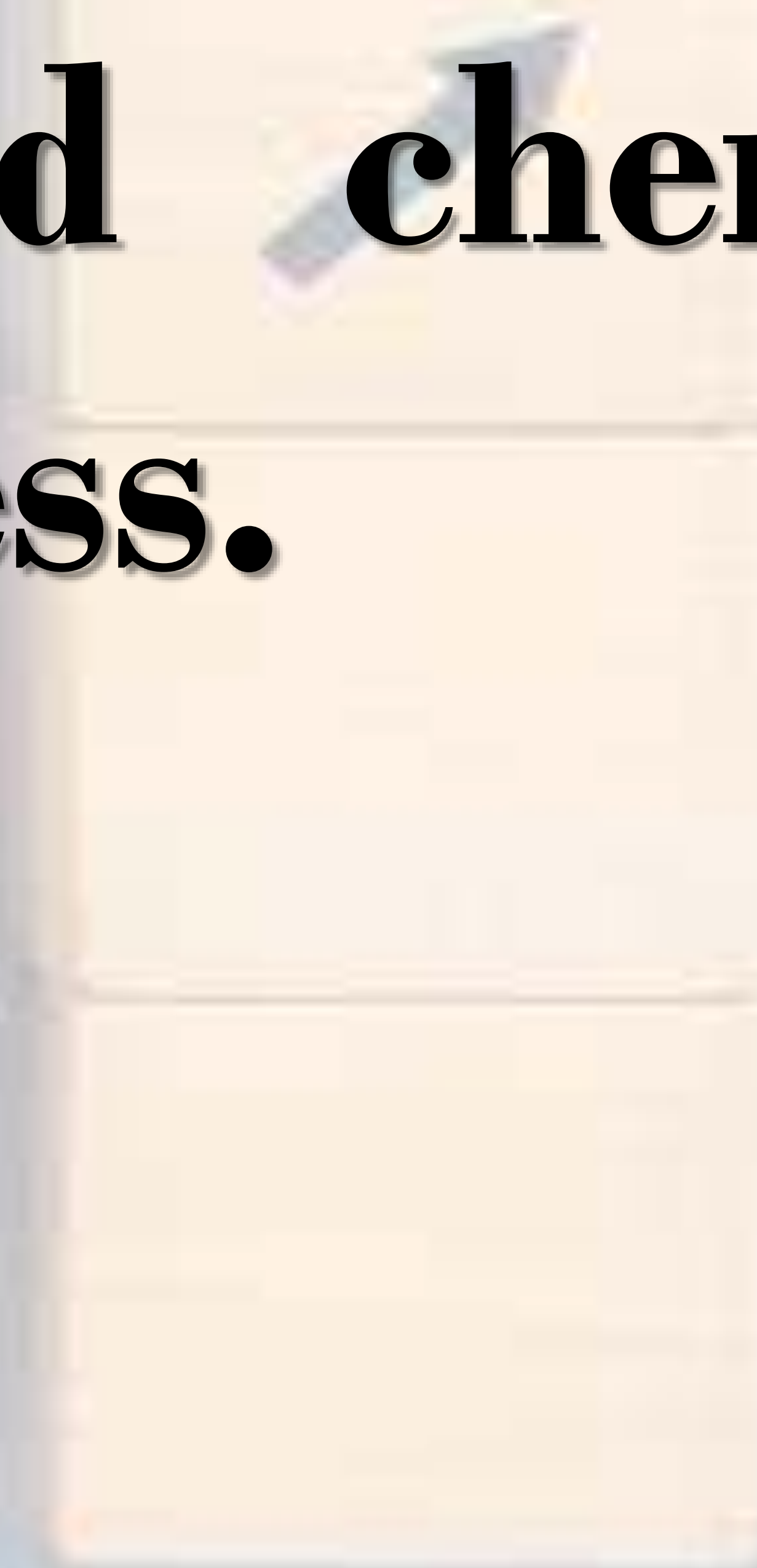

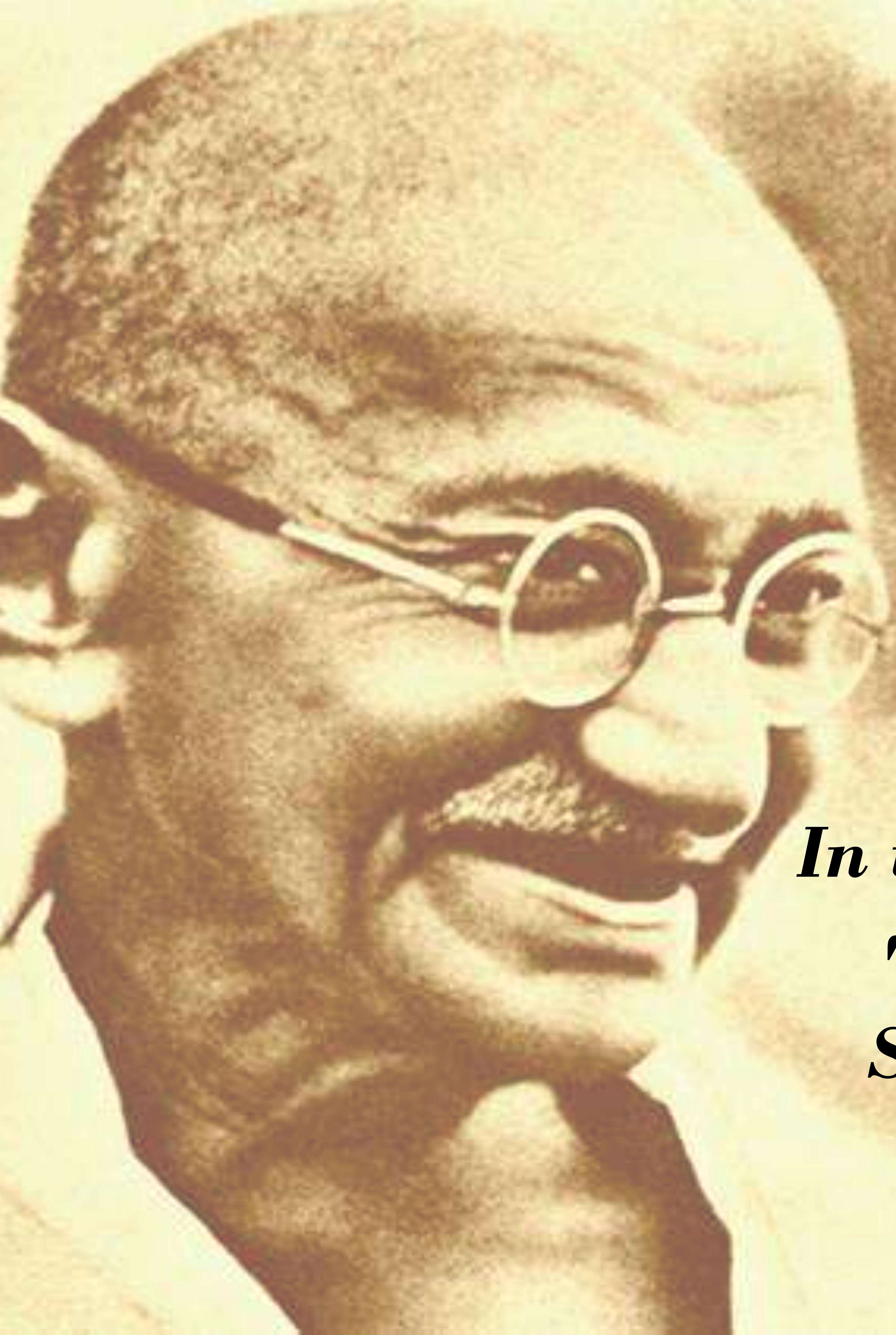


'Toprr's' online learning App

In the Radha Raman Inter State open Dance Competition 2019, our school team was placed at the 2nd position among 27 schools.



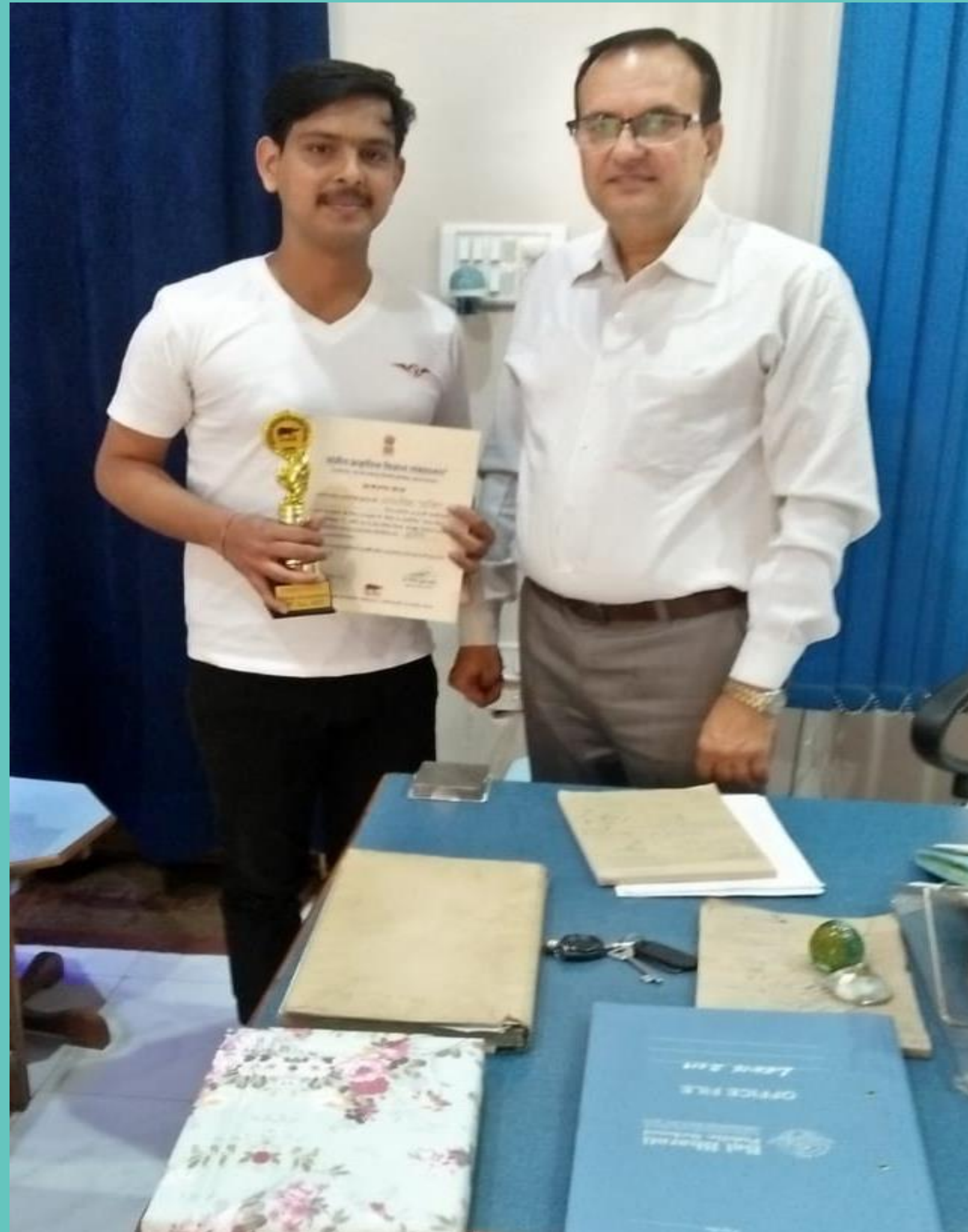
In an Inter School Folk Song Competition at Sagar Public School, Bhopal, our school team was declared the Runner's-up among 12 teams.

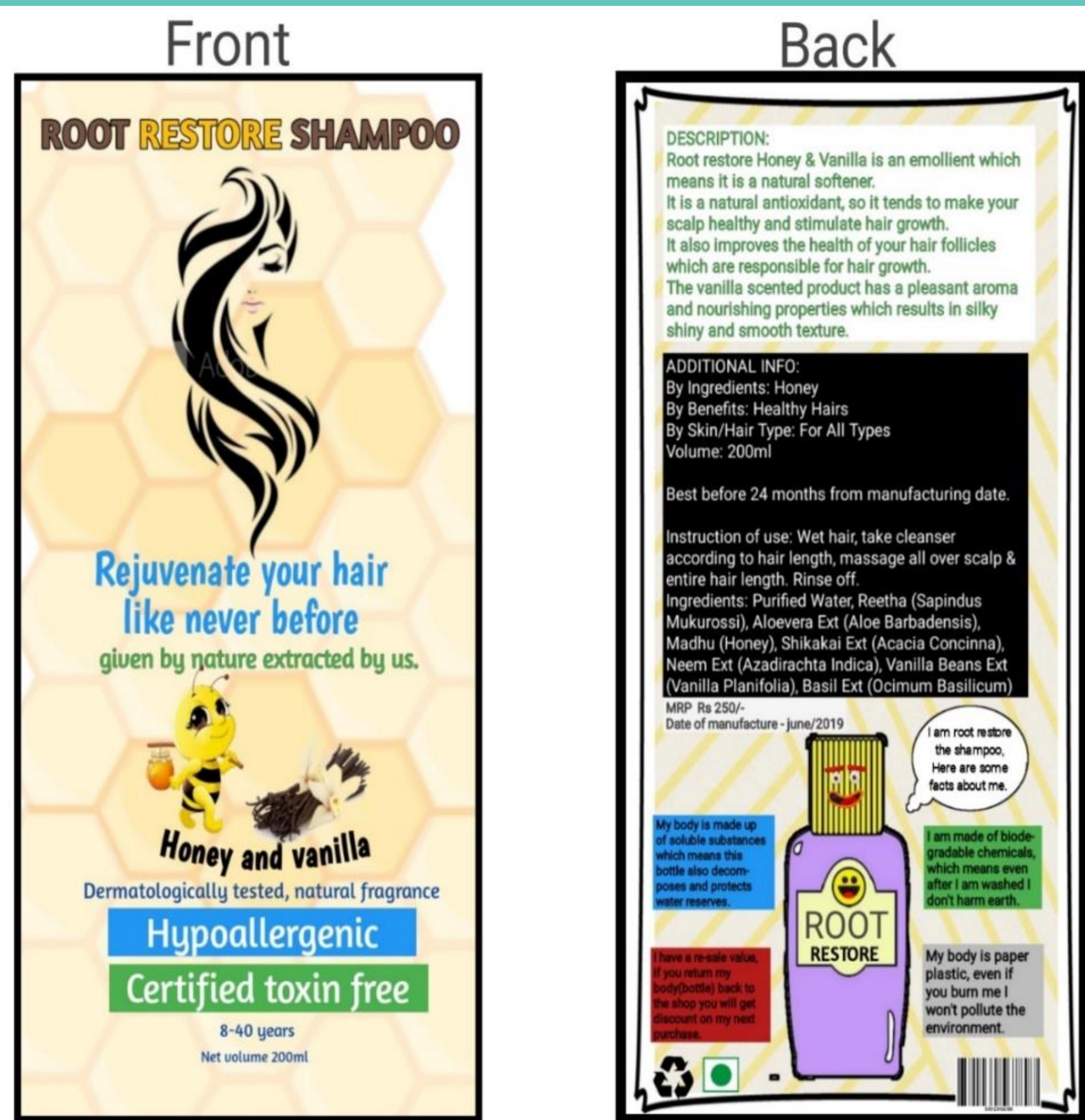
