


# 27<sup>th</sup> SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT "UDAAN-WINGS OF EDUCATION"




An IPS Officer, a grilled cricket player, an actor, a man with a spirit to explore and a human with strong believe in universal instances.

#### CBSE class X board result 2021-2022

I feel honored to mention that, we had 100% result. Top scorer was Govind Sharma with 96.80%. Out of 89 students who appeared, there were 63 students who secured first division. There were 4 students who secured 100% marks, 2 in Maths, 1 in Science and 1 in Social Science.



#### CBSE class XII board result 2021-2022

Top scorers were Jaya Sharma with 96.60% in Science stream and Aniket Litoriya with 92.40% in Commerce stream. Out of 76 students who appeared, there were 63 students who secured first division.

#### CBSE class X board result 2019-2020

We had 100% result this year too. Top scorer was Jaya Sharma with 98.00%. Out of 84 students who appeared, there were 69 students who secured first division. 3 students secured 100% marks, 2 in Soc. Sc. & and 1 in Hindi.



#### CBSE class XII board result 2019-2020

Top scorers were Mohd. Sameer with 95.40% in Science stream and Ekta Sahu with 93.40% in Commerce stream. Out of 64 students who appeared, there were 60 students who secured first division.







#### CBSE class X board result 2020-2021

We had 100% result for the academic year 2020-2021. Top scorer was Runjhun Batham with 96.60%. Out of 82 students who appeared, there were 77 students who secured first division. There were 4 students who secured 100% marks, 1 in Maths and 3 in Social Science.

Games and sports develop a sense of friendliness among the children and also build their team spirit. It helps children to develop mental and physical toughness.


Many students have participated in various events and have won laurels at the school.

Some of our achievements are:







In Sahodaya Interschool Kho-Kho Competition, organised by LNCT World School, Bhopal, our school team was placed at the second position.




In Sahodaya Interschool Basketball Competition, organised by IES Public School, Bhopal, our school team was placed at the second position.




In Sahodaya Interschool Volleyball Competition, organised by SAGE International School, Bhopal.




In the 18<sup>th</sup> National Karate Championship , organised at Badminton Hall, Bhopal.


