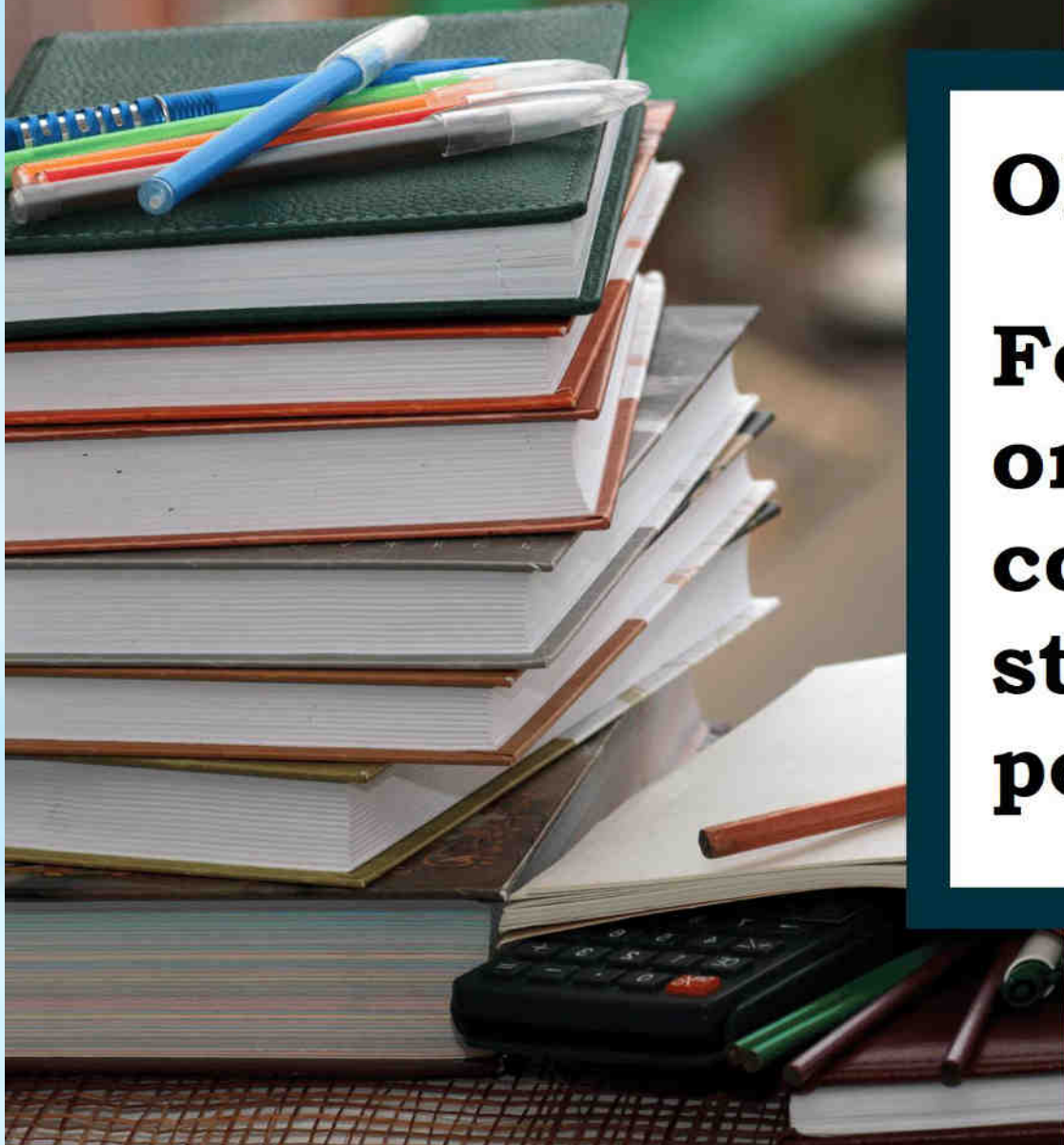

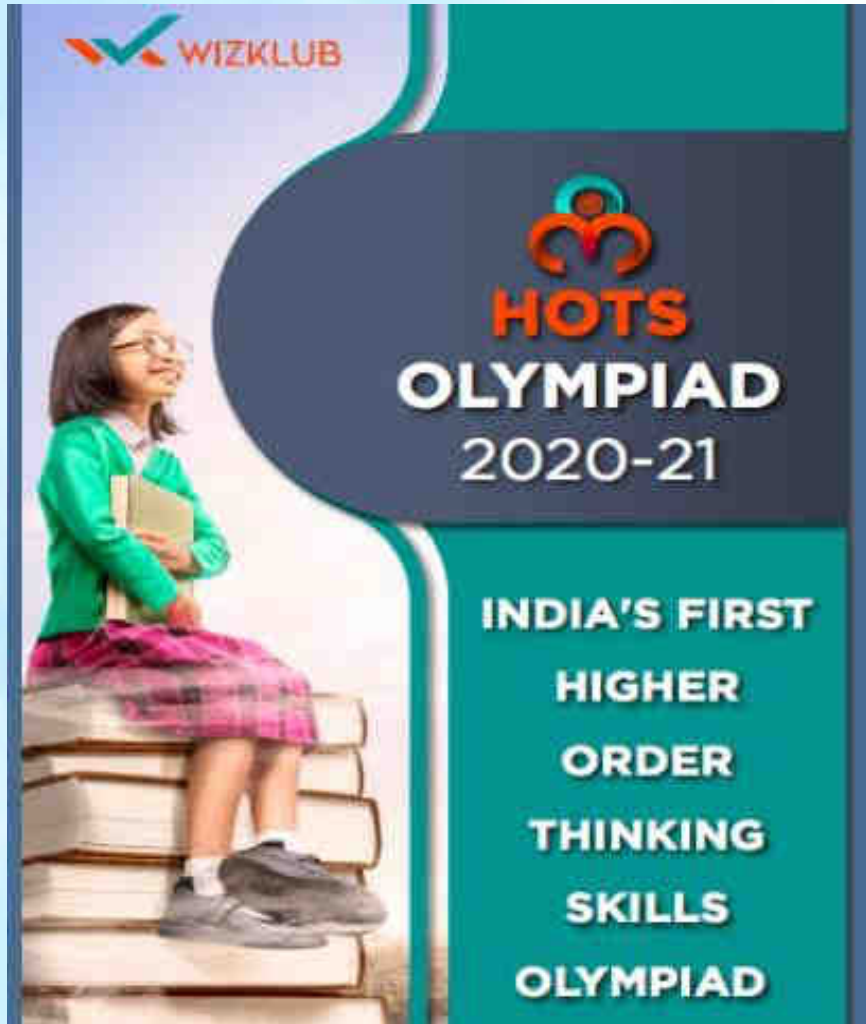

OPEN EXAMS

Following academic oriented exams were conducted for the students, during the period under report:

In an International HOTS (Higher Order Thinking Skills) Olympiad, organised by Wizklub, students from classes II to VII participated. The same was organised virtually in which 52 students participated and 34 students were selected for the prelim round. Out of the 34 students, 32 students have been selected for the next round. 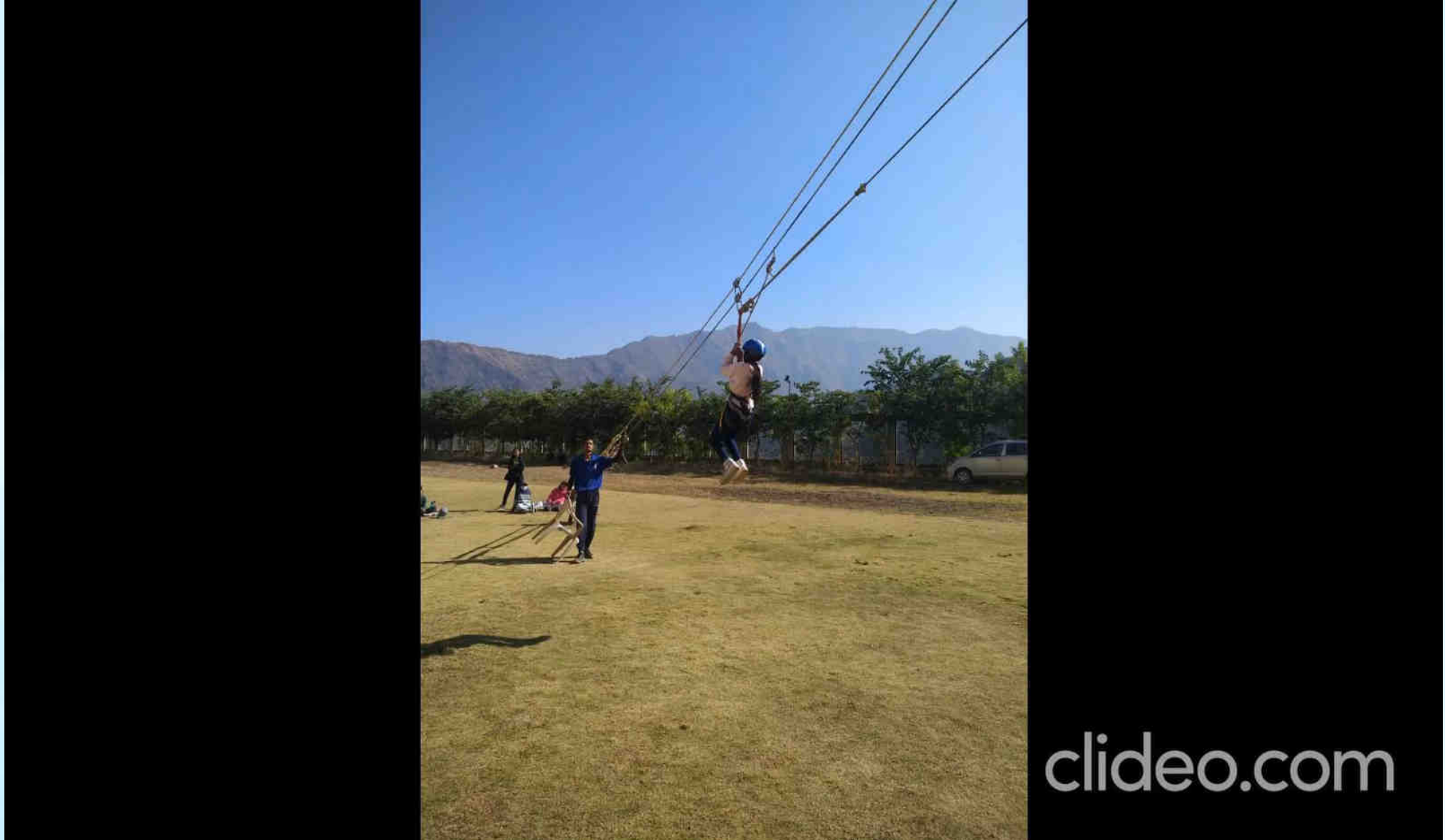




SCHOOL TOUR

- Visitors are restricted to enter into the school premises without entry at the reception.

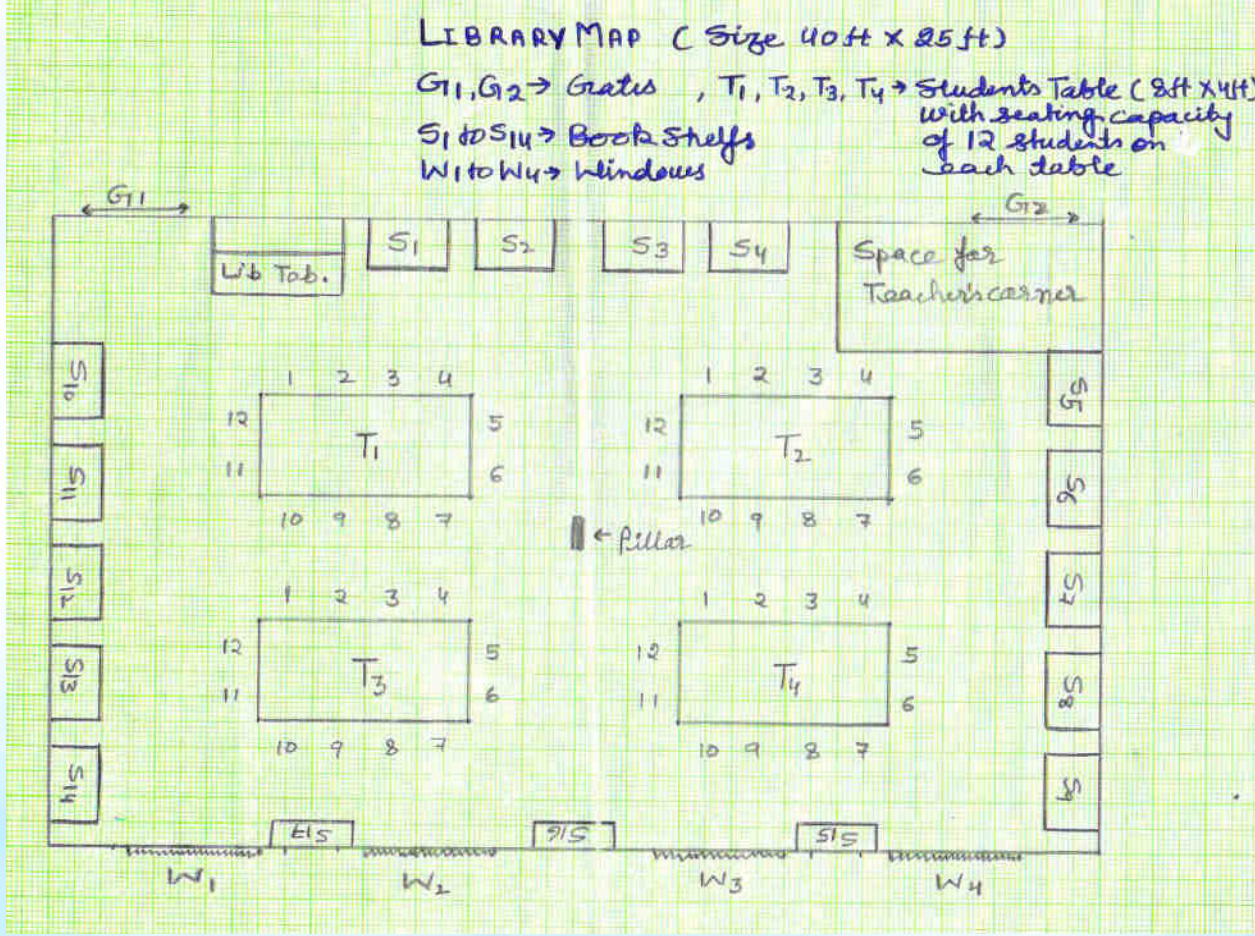

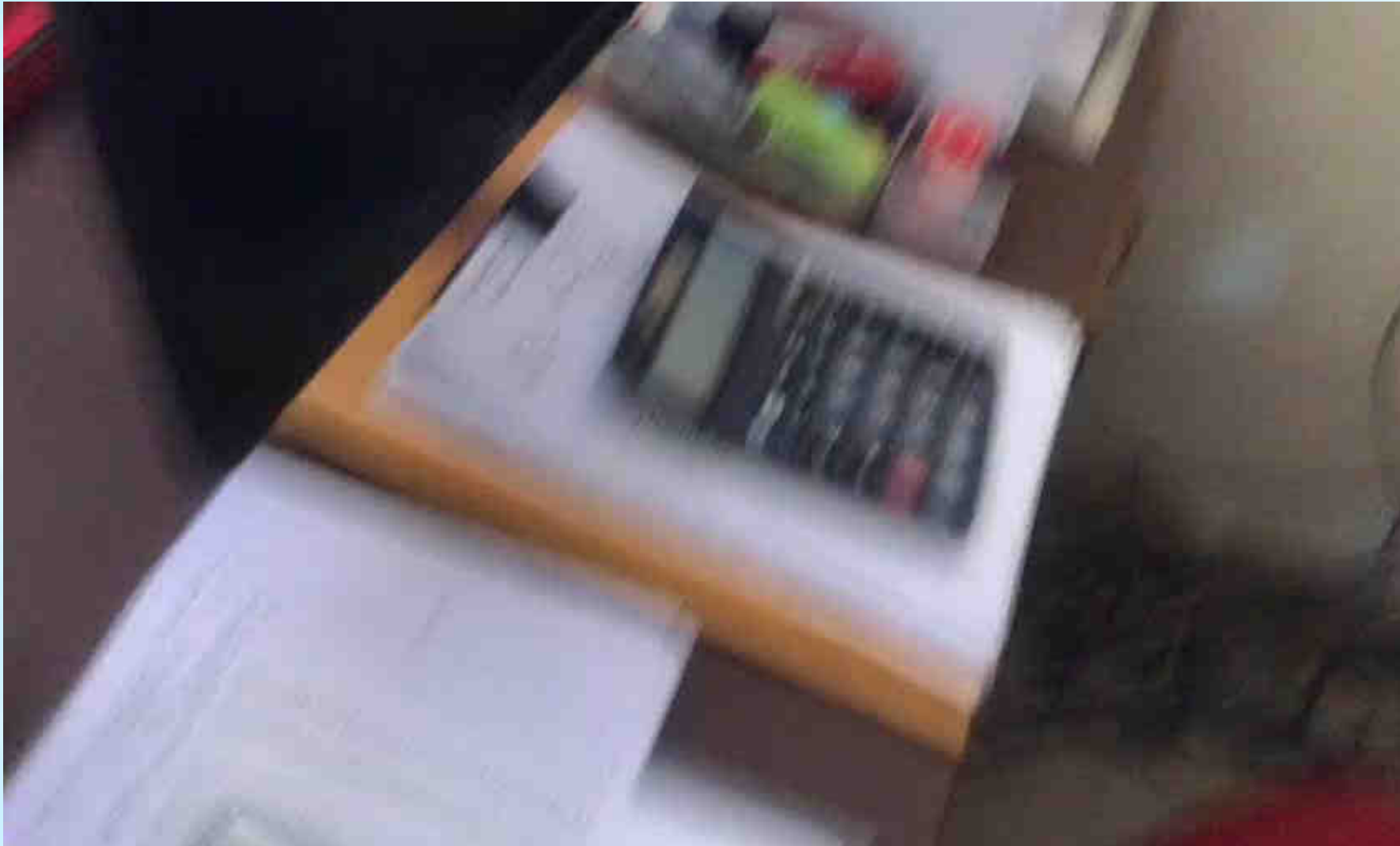


DISCIPLINE

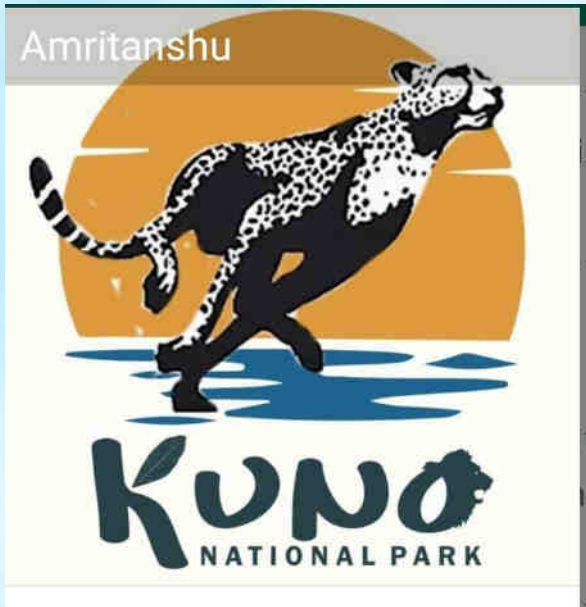


STAFF MEETINGS
