She will be missed and remembered by each one of us.

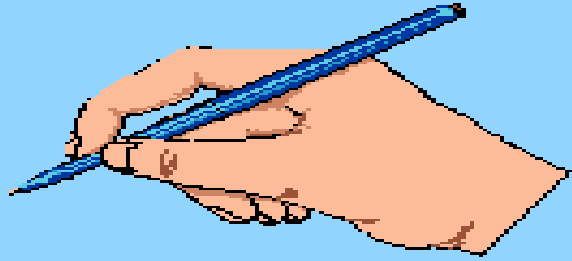

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

- Mr. Mukesh Tiwari, Ex-PRT (Music) has lodged a case in Labour Court of Bhopal to release his payment of gratuity and leave encashment. Based upon the Enquiry Report of the disciplinary proceedings, he was terminated from his services on 30 May, 2016. It was mentioned in his termination letter to clear all his pending dues after obtaining clearance certificate from the school. Mr. Mukesh, inspite of 3 gentle reminders sent by the school did not respond and hence the school did not release his full and final dues.
- The principal in person has been attending all the hearings. The details of the hearings are as follows-
 - **First Hearing**- 17 Feb, 2021- The Advocate at Bhopal has submitted the reply to the Labour Court in response to the petition received by the school. Next date of hearing was 7 April, 2021.
 - **Second Hearing**- 7 April 2021- Due to Covid-19, the case was adjourned. Next date of hearing was 3 June 2021.
 - **Third Hearing**- 3 June 2021- Due to Covid-19, the case was adjourned. Next date of hearing was 6 August 2021.
 - **Fourth Hearing**- 6 August 2021- The date of hearing was for applicant's evidence. Next date of hearing was 24 September 2021.

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

- **Fifth Hearing**- 24 September 2021- Applicant Mr. Mukesh Tiwari had filed his affidavit and he was cross examined on the affidavit. The next date of hearing was 12 November 2021.
- **Sixth Hearing**- 12 November 2021- The school had filed affidavit of evidence for cross examination. The next date of hearing was 17 December 2021.
- **Seventh Hearing**- 17 December 2021- The school has submitted the copy of hindi translation of affidavit of evidence. The next date of hearing has been scheduled on 20 January 2022 for non- applicant evidence.

Academics

- As per the M.P. Govt. notification, the School re-opened for the students of Classes I to XII on 22 November, 2021. As on date, 50% of the students are attending the physical school.
- Classes I to V had their 2nd Block Test and classes VI to XII had their Mid Term Examination beginning from 16 September, 2021 to 1 October, 2021. PTM for the same was scheduled on 23 October, 2021.
- Term -I examination for classes X and XII have been scheduled from 20 November, 2021 to 28 December, 2021. Our school is a centre for students from Demonstration School, Bhopal and our own students.

- Classes I to V had their 3rd Block Test and classes VI to VII had their Post Mid Term Examination beginning from 8 December, 2021 to 16 December, 2021. PTM for the same has been scheduled in the month of January 2021.
- As per the guidelines received from MP Govt. dated 28 November, 2021, only 50% students are allowed to attend the school. Time table has been recasted and has been forwarded to the students.
- Online classes for those who are not attending offline classes are being organized through Google Meet and Google Classroom as per the time table to continue the hassle-free teaching learning process from classes I to XII since April 2021.
- Virtual Class Observation. In order to improve the teaching-learning process, classes are being observed on a regular basis by the Principal.

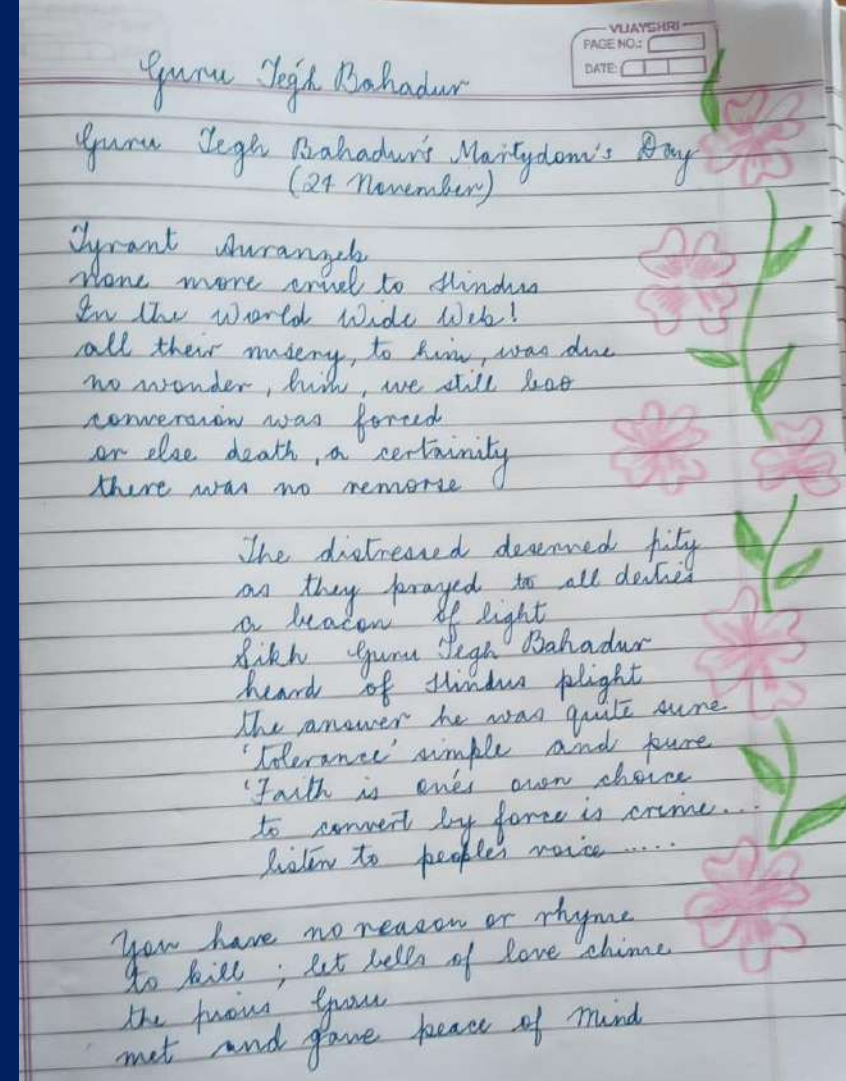
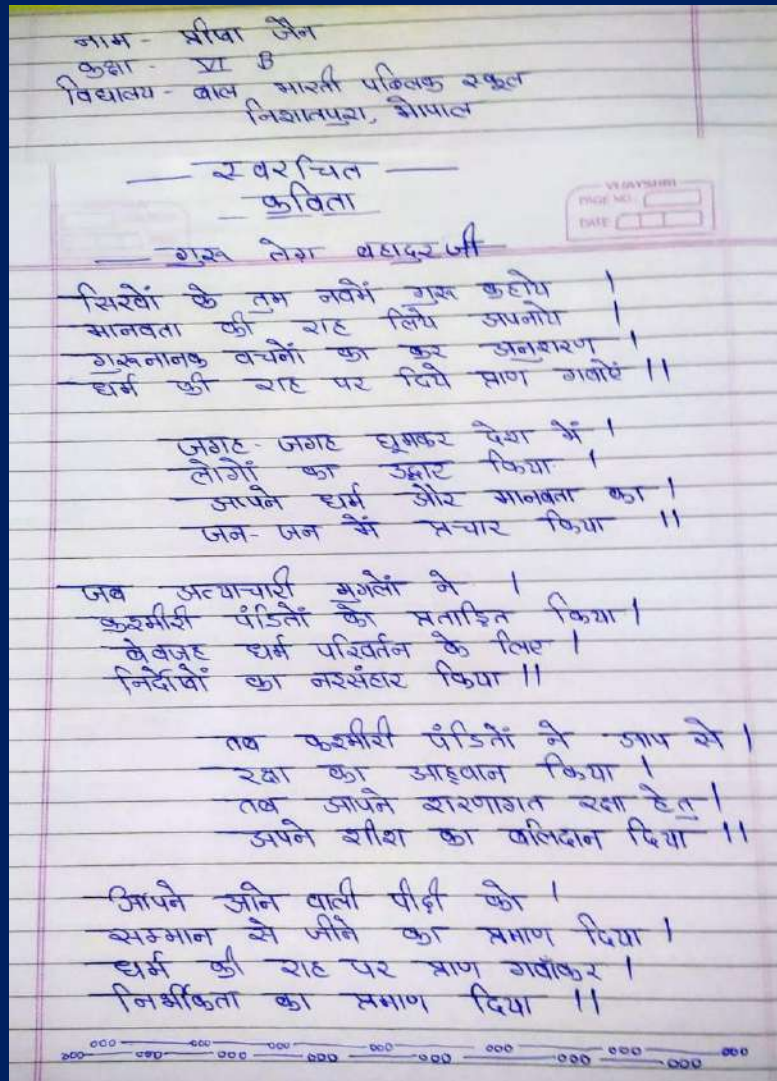
Swachhata Pakhwada

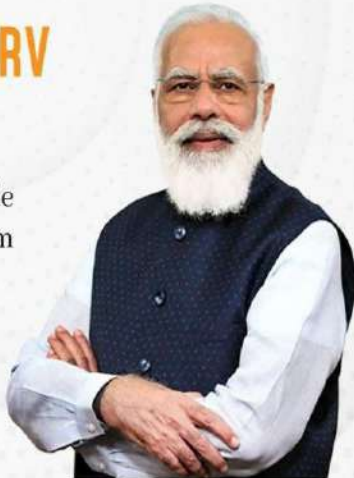

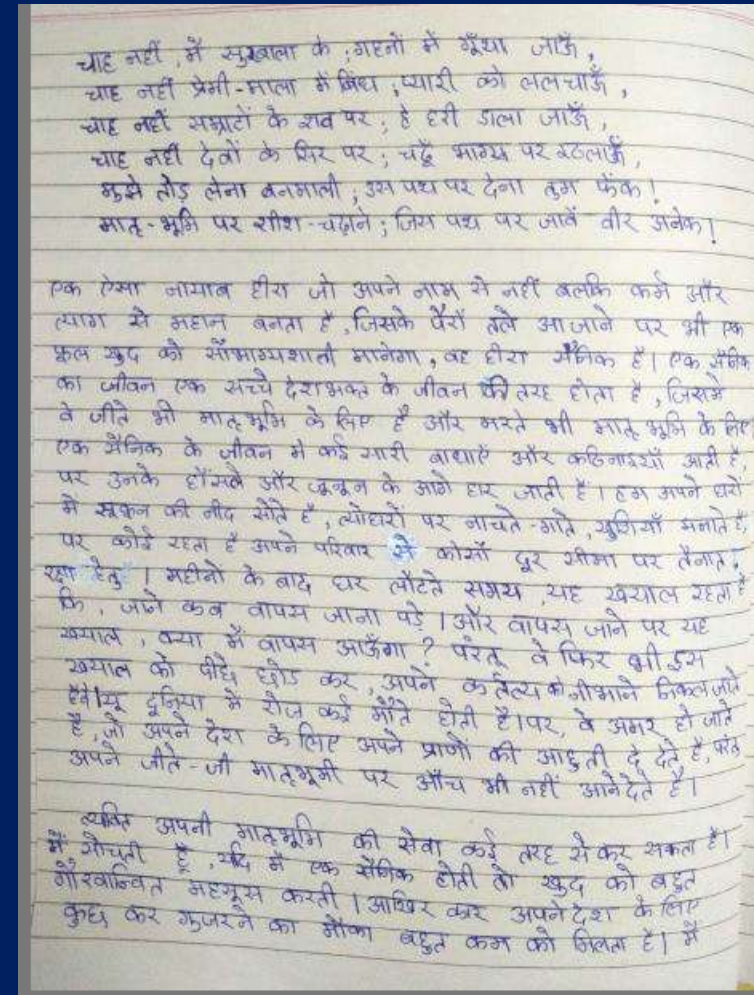
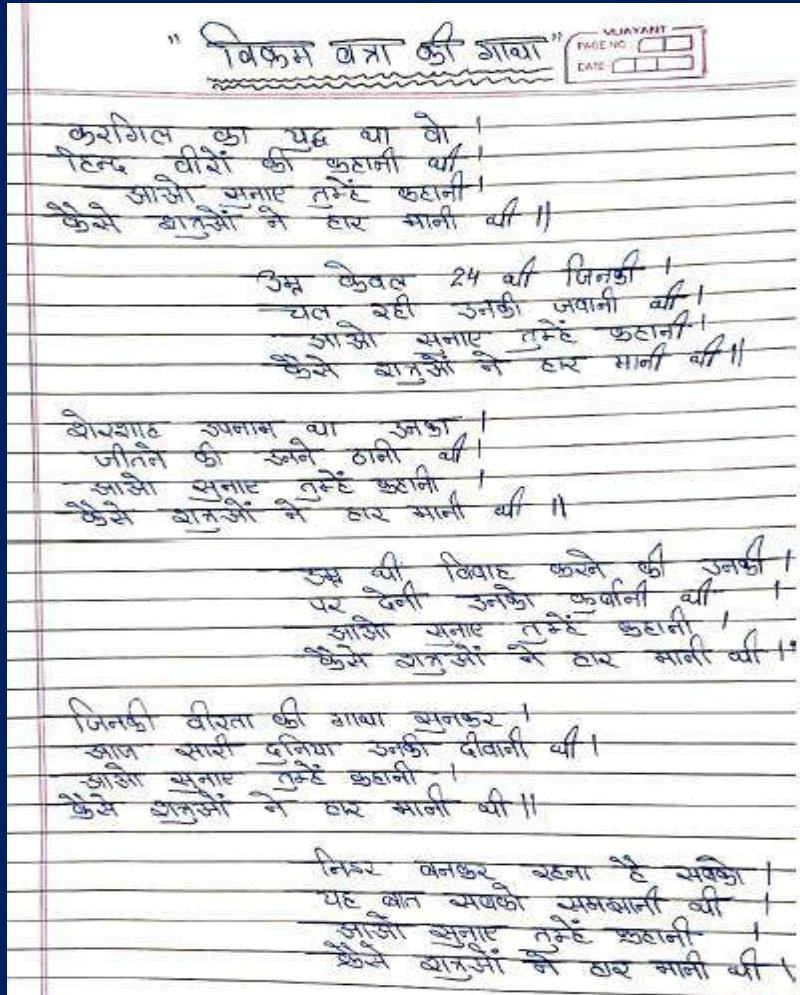
'Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day)'

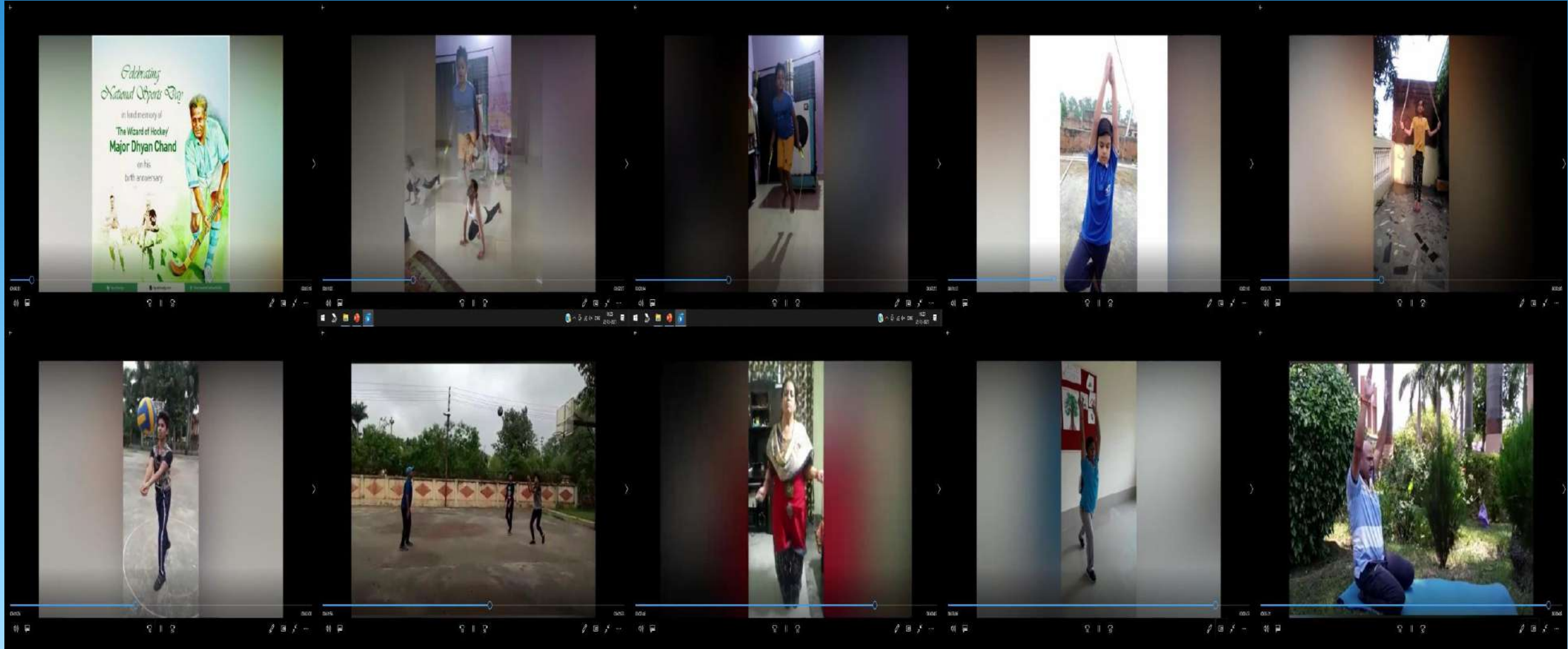
On the occasion, the students presented dance performances and delivered speeches to symbolize the festival of lights. A presentation of the same was circulated to all the students.

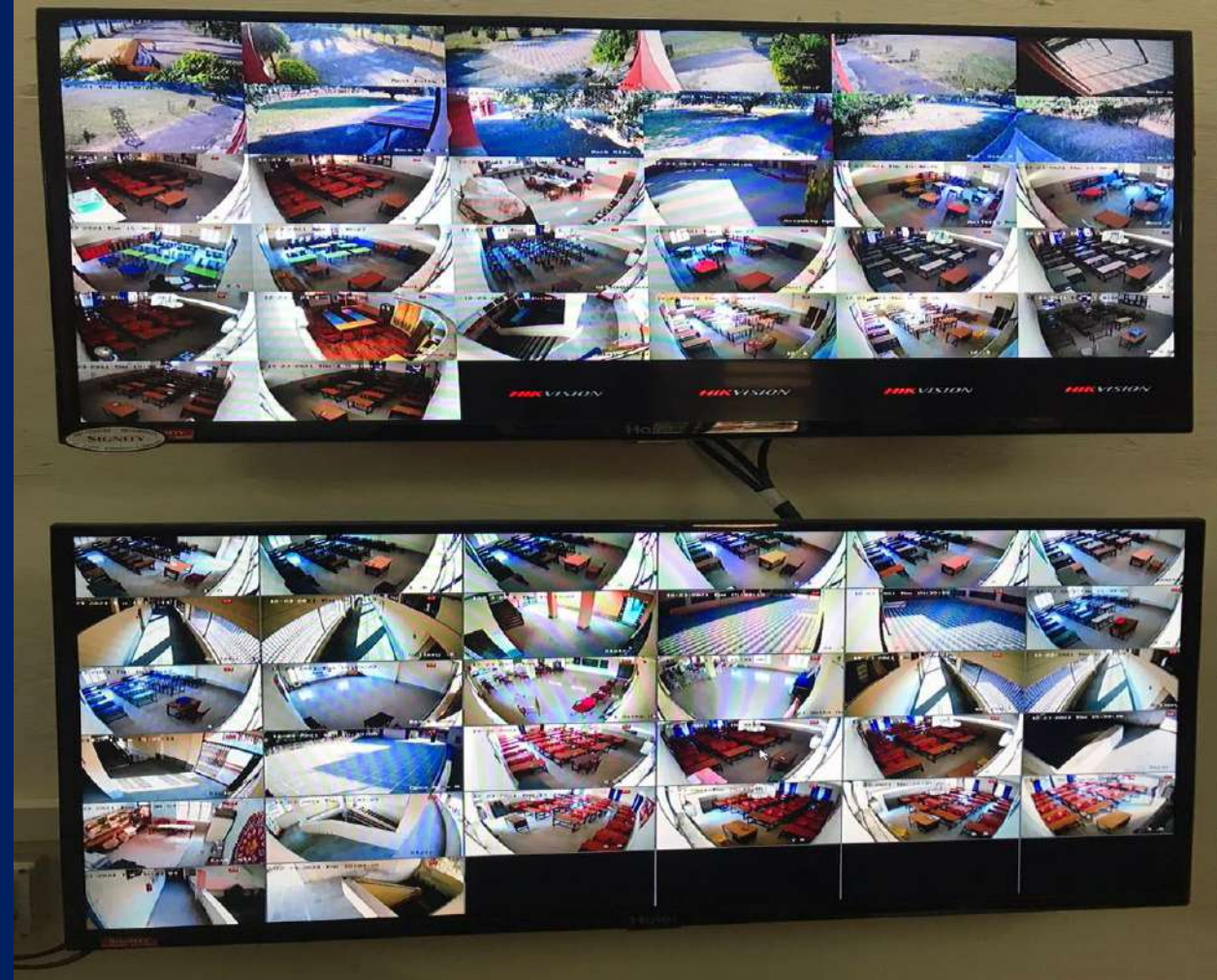

Three sweepers, one gardener and one peon are working in the school at present. P.E.T- Mr. Deepak Dhote is appointed as supervisor to supervise their work.

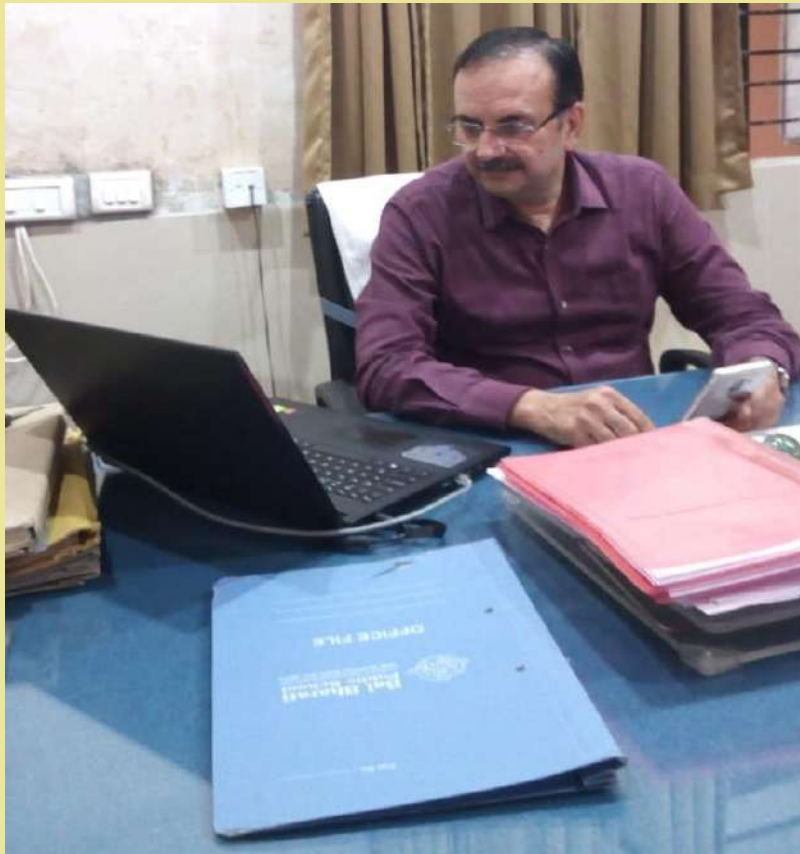



DISCIPLINE.
