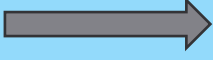

## CASE -I

- Mr. Mukesh Tiwari, Ex-PRT (Music) had lodged a case in Labour Court of Bhopal to release his payment of gratuity and leave encashment and interest towards the late payment.

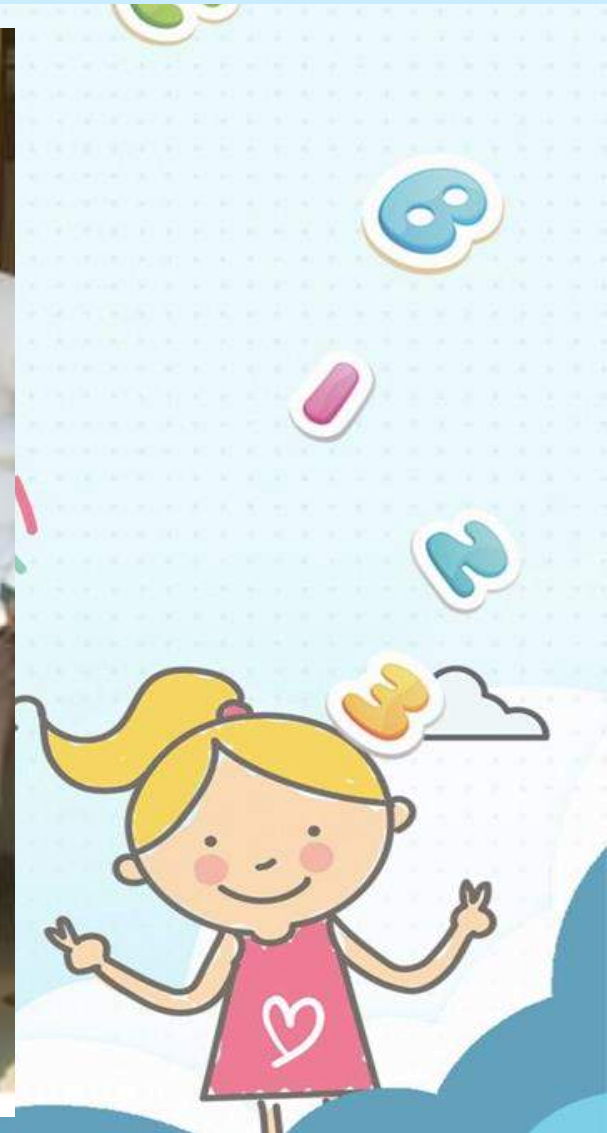
## DIWALI

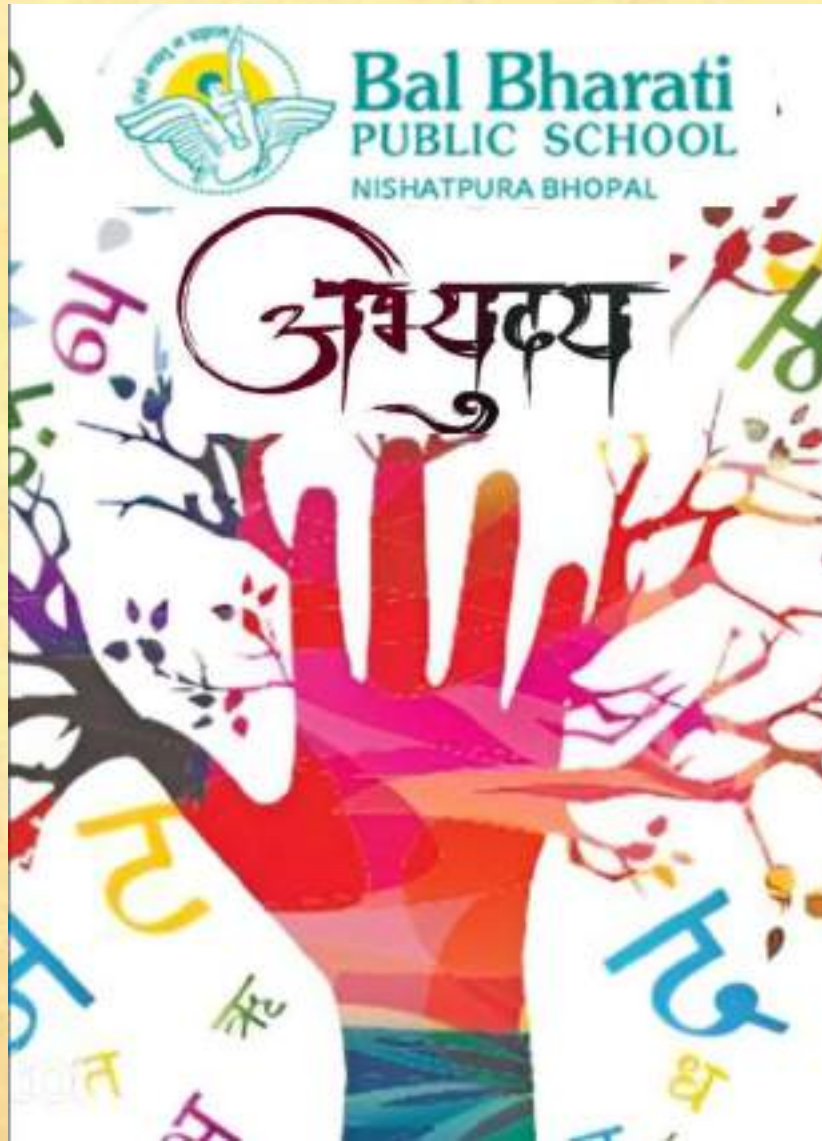


## CHILDREN'S DAY

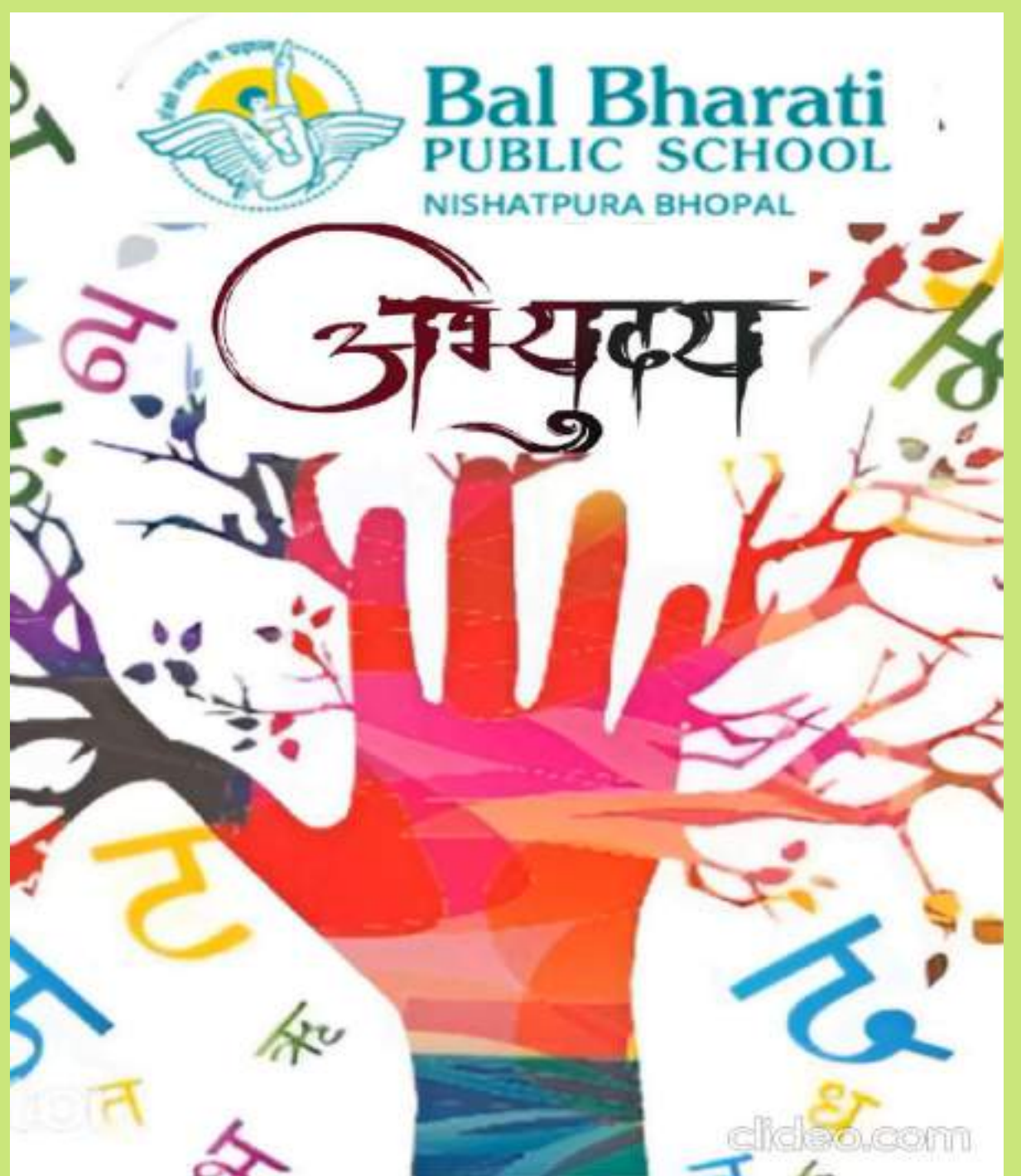

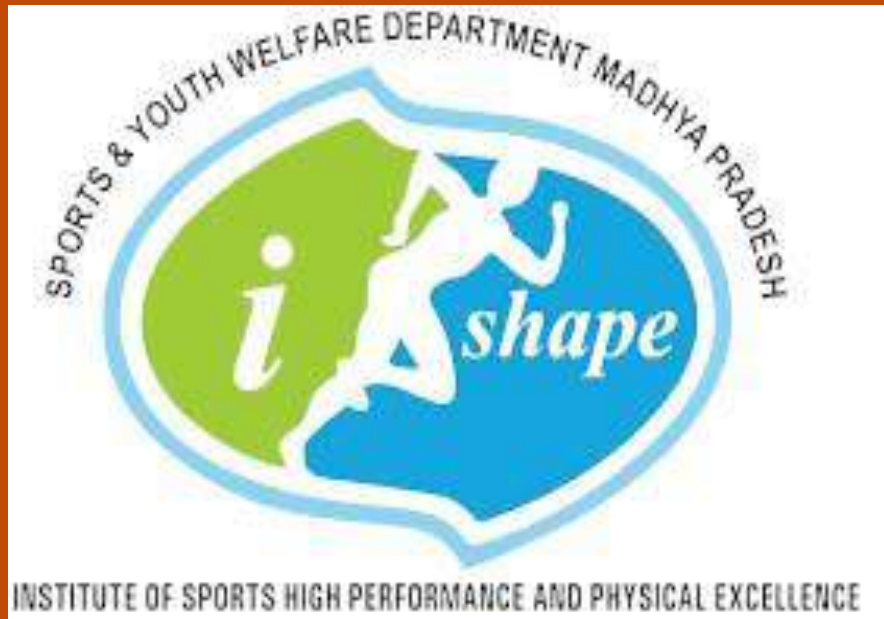

The school's general discipline has been good. There were few cases of students bunking the class. Their parents were called and were made aware of the act.





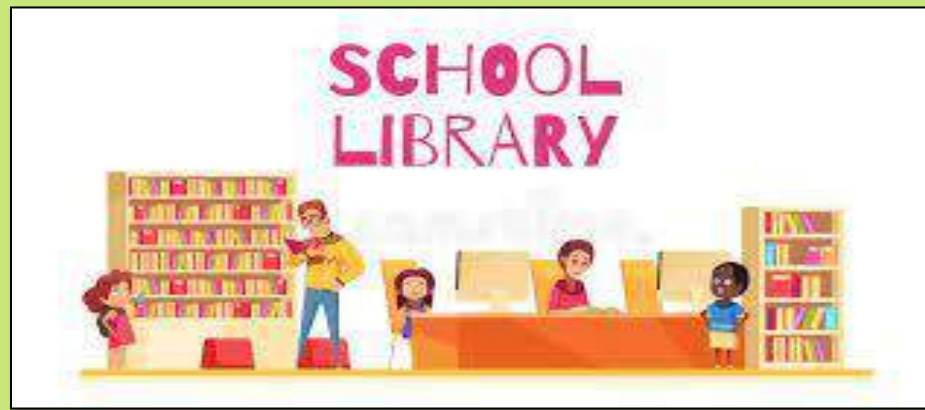
At present, M/s Ex Service Security and Man Power Services are hired as housekeeping agency on a contractual basis for the period under report.






