CHRISTIMAS DAY


The feast day was celebrated virtually, the students sang hymns and preached about the Christ's birth






VOTER'S DAY

An online poster making competition was organised for the students of class VI to IX exhibiting and encourage more young voters to take part in the political process.








WORLD CANCER DAY

An informative presentation was made to raise the awareness of cancer and to encourage its prevention, detection and treatment.








WORLD SOCIAL JUSTICE DAY


As on date there are 17 fee defaulters of session 2019-20. Total amount due is Rs. 79230/-.
