

- Classes I to V had their 3rd Block Test and classes VI to VIII had their Post Mid Term Examination beginning from 16 December 2020 to 24 December 2020. PTM for the same was scheduled on 3 January 2021.

The online exams were conducted in three parts, Objective Assessment, Subjective Assessment and Oral Assessment. Google form and Google classroom have proved to be effective tools.

- 1st Pre- Board Examination for classes X & XII was conducted in an offline mode from 4 January 2021 to 16 January 2021. An offline PTM, in a slot manner, was scheduled on 25 January 2021.
- Pre-Annual Examination for classes IX & XI were scheduled from 27 January 2021 to 10 February 2021. PTM for the same was scheduled on 20 February 2021
- Classes I to V had their 4th Block Test and classes VI to VIII had their Final Examination beginning from 22 February 2021 to 12 March 2021. Offline PTM for the same has been scheduled in slot wise manner on 20, 22 and 23 March 2021.

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- 2nd Pre- Board Examination for classes X & XII was conducted in an offline mode from 1 March 2021 to 13 March 2021. An offline PTM has been scheduled on 22 March 2021.
 - Final Examination for classes IX & XI has been scheduled from 15 March 2021 to 31 March 2021. But as per the announcement by the MP Govt. in respect to lockdown and closure of school upto 31 March 2021 we have postponed the exams till further orders.
 - **Virtual Class Observation**. In order to improve the teaching-learning process, classes are being observed on a regular basis by the Principal.

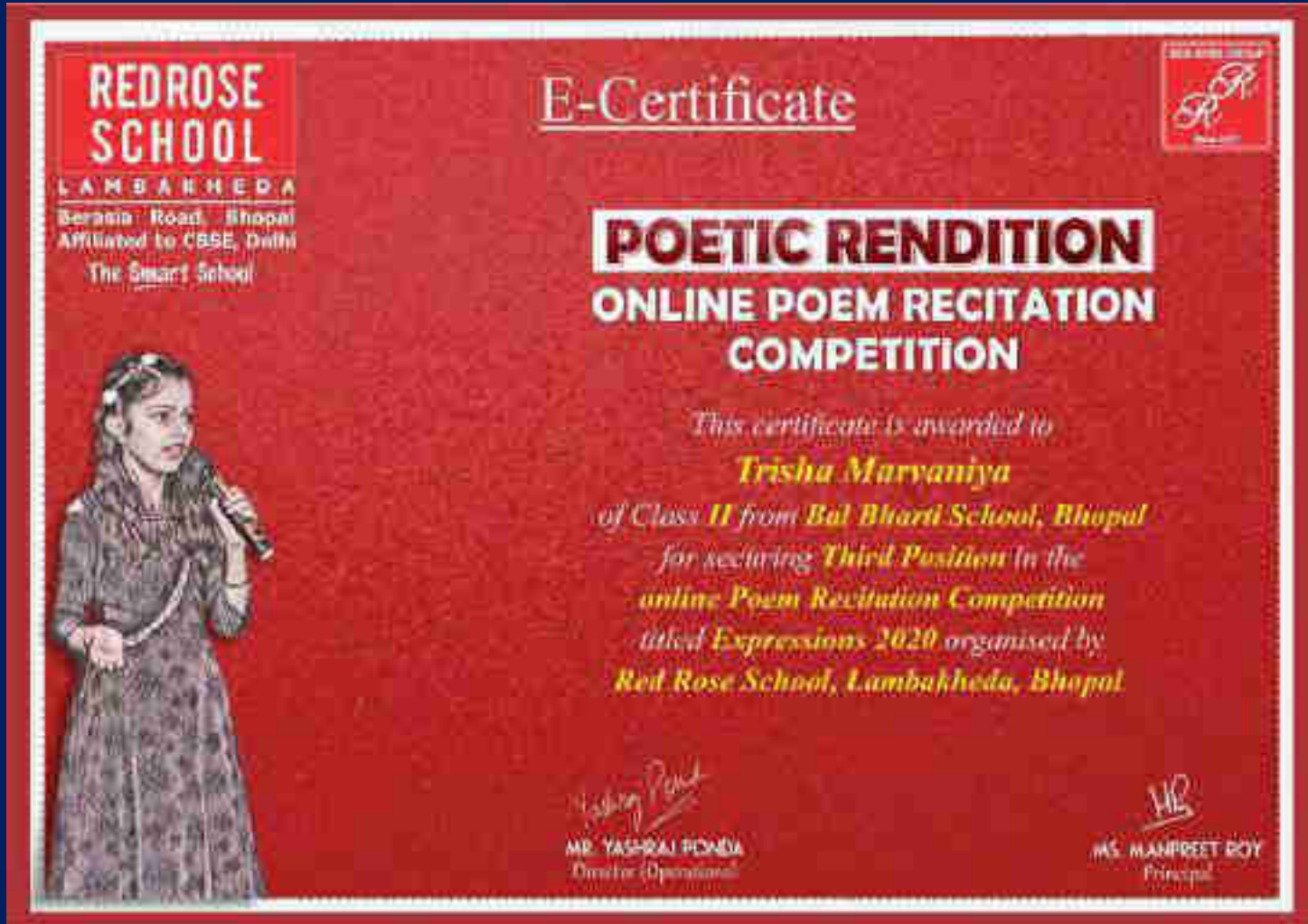

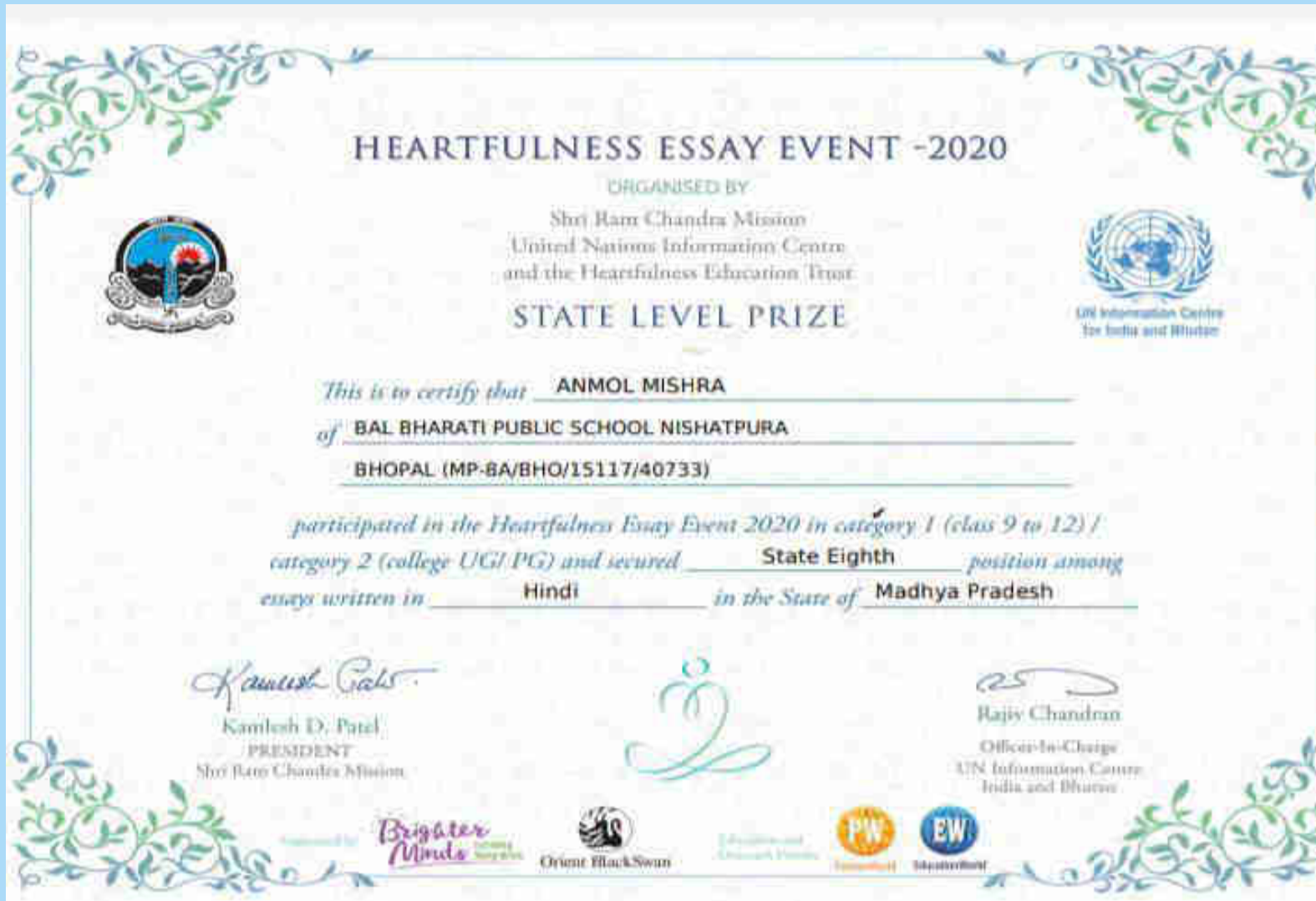

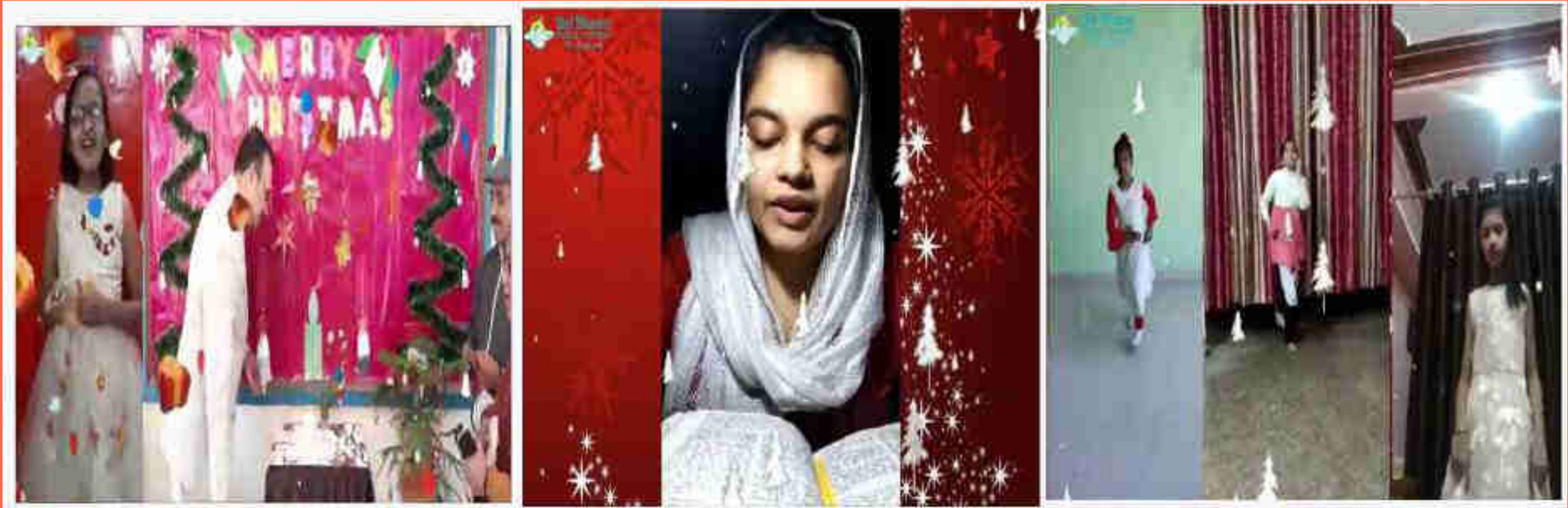
