


Special Decasions

An online Drawing Competition was organised for the students depicting the main goal of this day which is to focus the attention on the importance of population issues.






WORLD SANSKRIT DAY


WORLD HEPATITIS DAY






EID CELEBRATION



Results of the JEE Mains 2020 brought laurels to the school. 07 students of Session 2019-2020 qualified the prestigious examination.

















- > Aryan Suryavanshi of class III was placed at the third position along with cash prize of Rs. 1600/-.










