Results of the JEE Mains 2020 brought laurels to the school. 07 students of Session 2019-2020 qualified the prestigious examination.



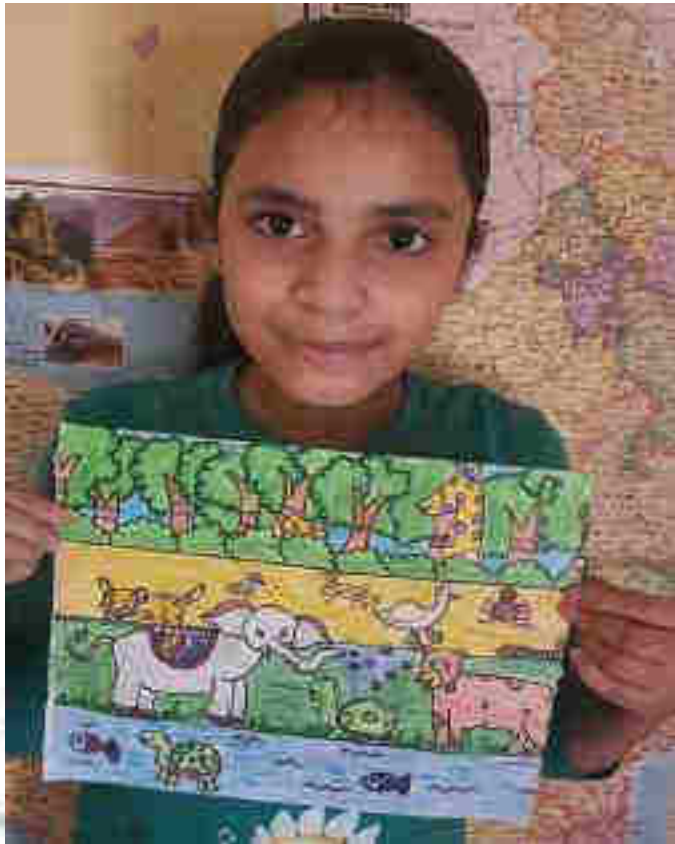

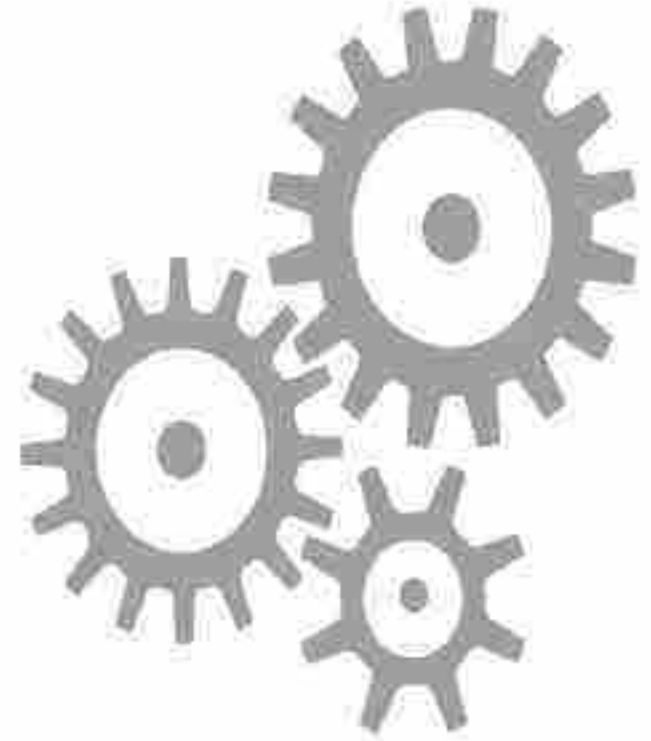
