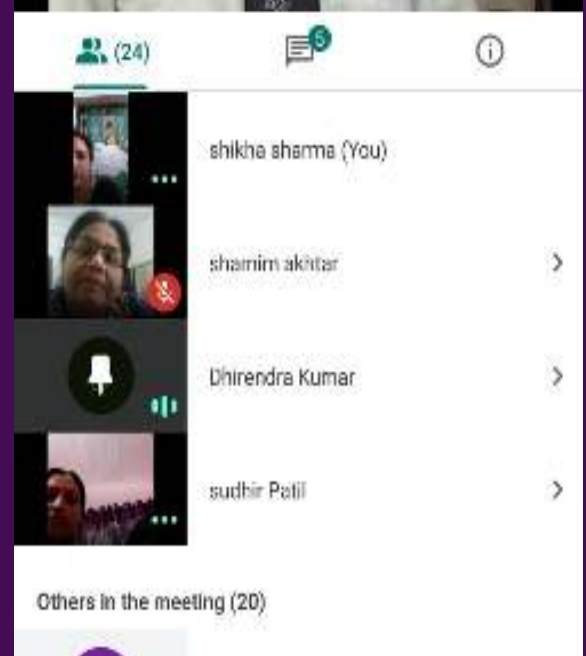

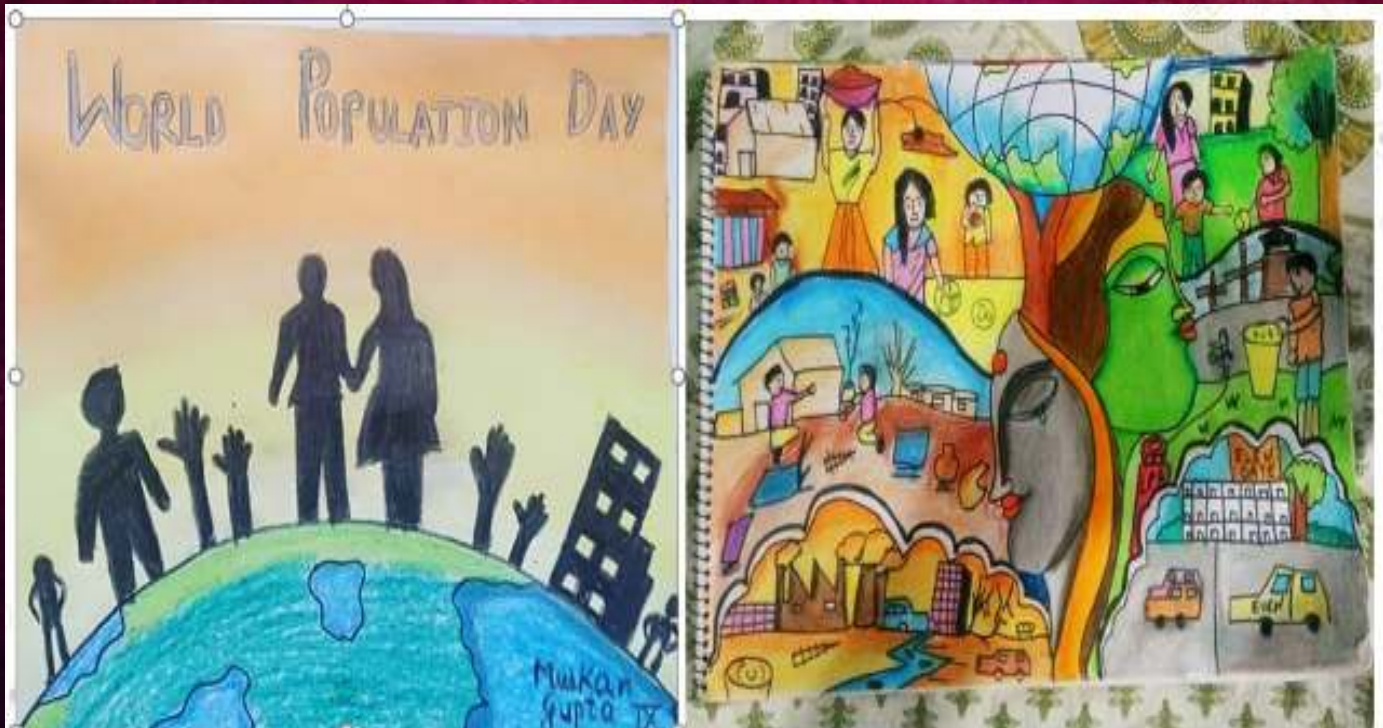


WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY- The theme for World Environment Day

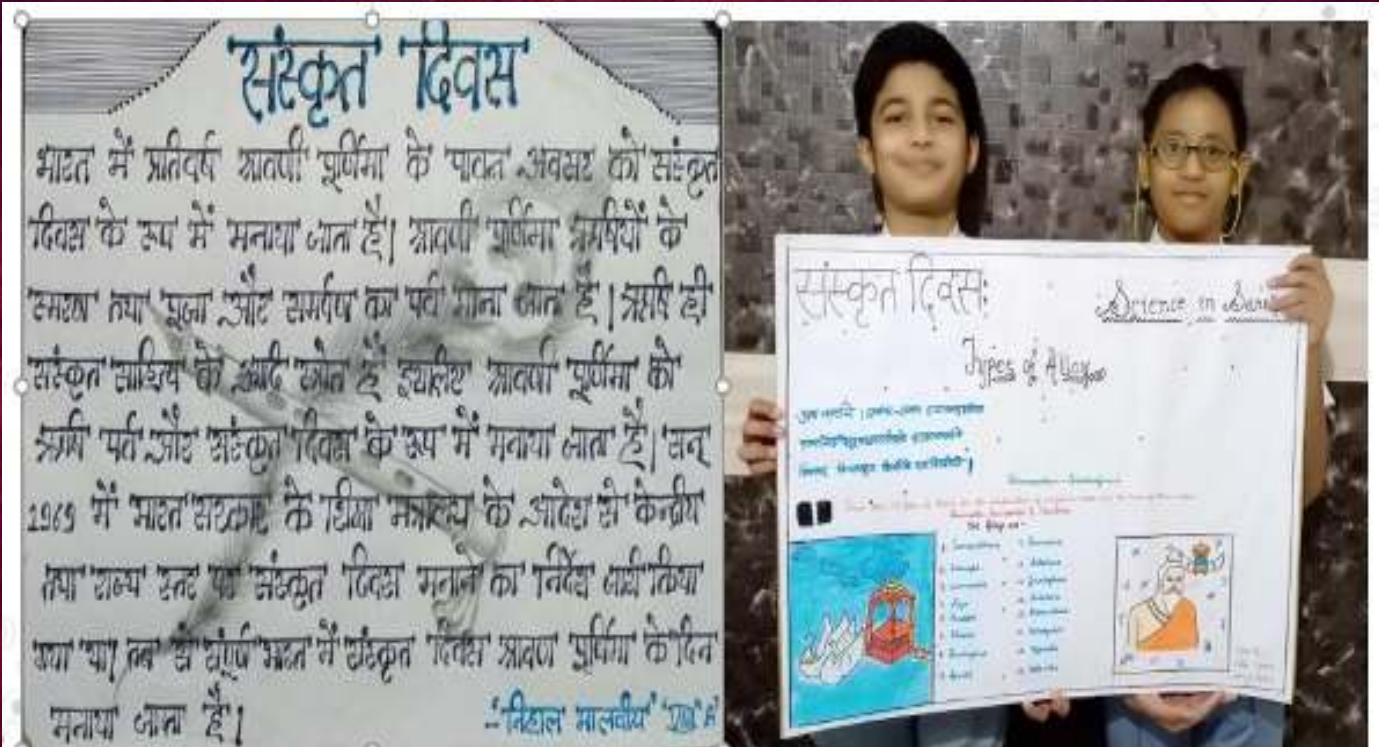

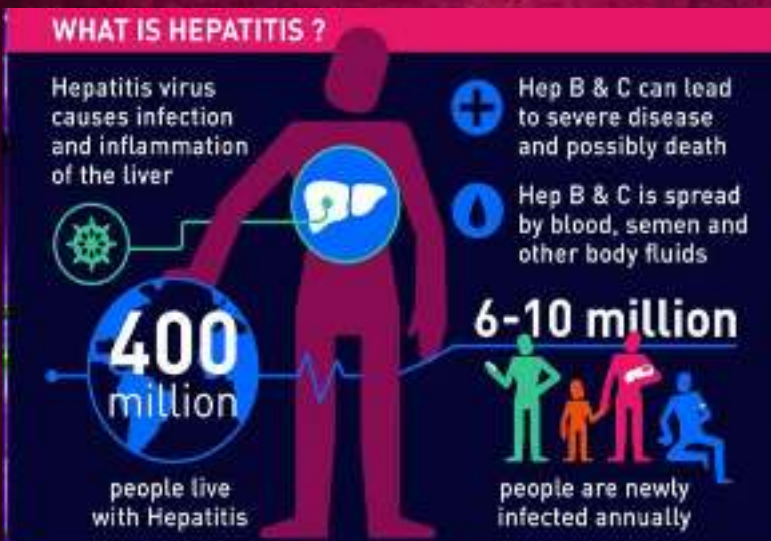
WORLD POPULATION DAY- An online Drawing Competition was organised for the students depicting the main goal of this day which is to focus the attention on the importance of population issues.



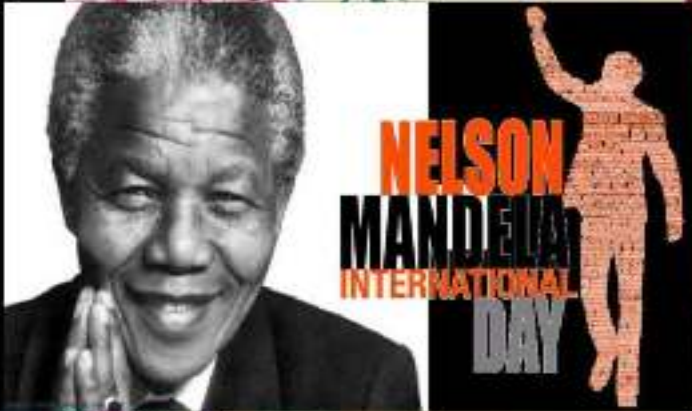
WORLD SANSKRIT DAY- An online Shlok Uchcharan competition was organised for the students making them aware of the ancient Indian language.
